

Security

The ELC930 has the benefit of Ingenico's world-wide acclaim with regards to security and reliability. It reads CMC7 characters printed at the bottom of cheques, and provides POS systems (cash registers or payment terminals) with information allowing retailers to consult cheque authorisation centres, in turn delivering optimum security for both consumer and merchant.

Performance

The ELC930 combines simplicity and speed. The cheque is simply introduced, then read and printed in less than 2 seconds while the electronic control of the printer ensures perfect, economical working order. The inkjet cartridge can be changed in an instant and the permanent accessibility of the cheque prevents it from jamming.

Design/Ergonomics

With its compact design and refined ergonomics, this cheque reader/printer easily fits into any point of sale, whether it is discreetly placed under a payment terminal or elegantly displayed on its side next to a cash register. Its modern and colourful design makes it suitable to any environment.

Communication

The ELC930 can be connected to any equipment that manages the protocol specified by the payment systems industry (Concert) including serial and USB ports. Connected to an Ingenico payment terminal, it forms a powerful card and cheque POS system able not only to print invoices, lists and daily takings, but also to electronically transmit cheque images and access authentication centres.
